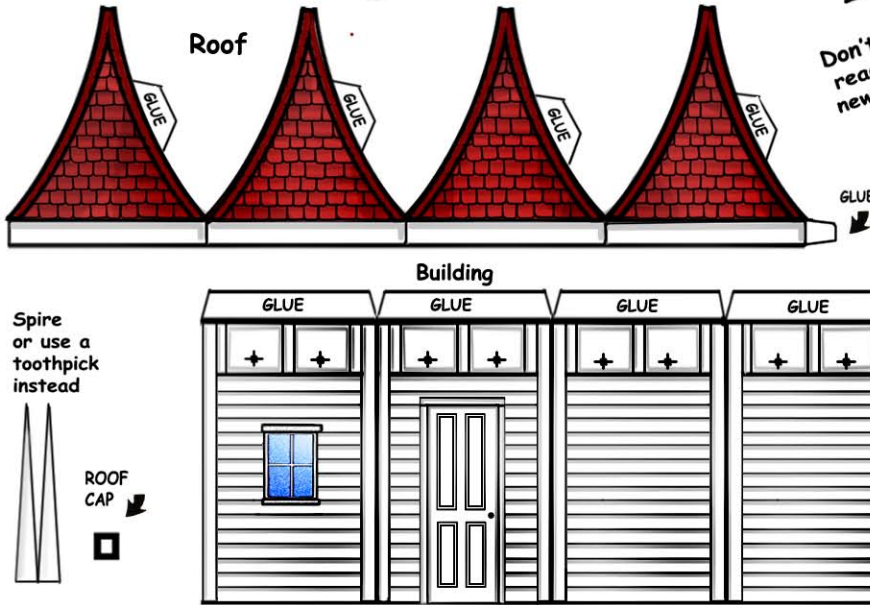
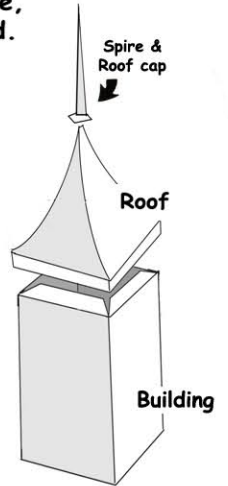


# A Classy Privy

Don't forget to bring reading material, a newspaper or catalog will do.



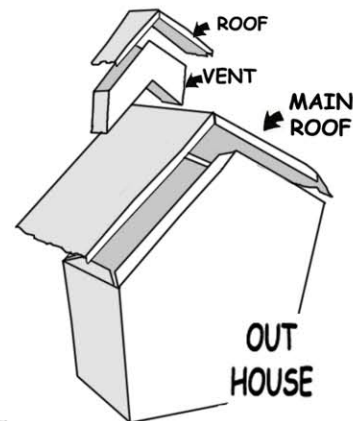

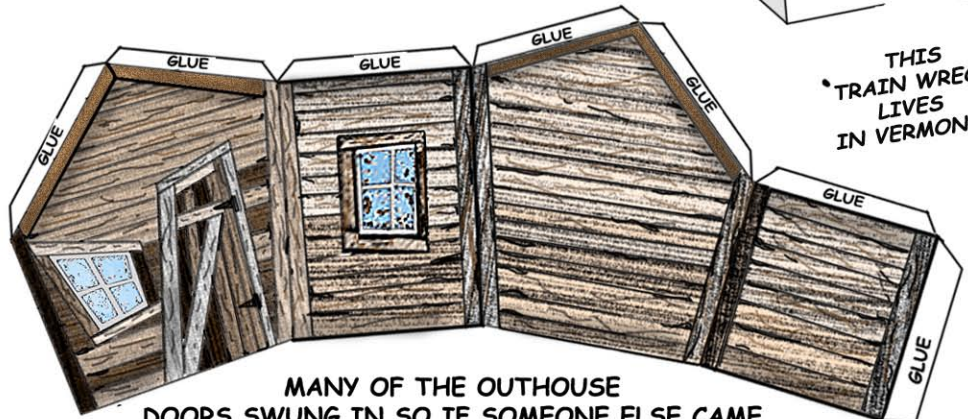

# OUT HOUSE

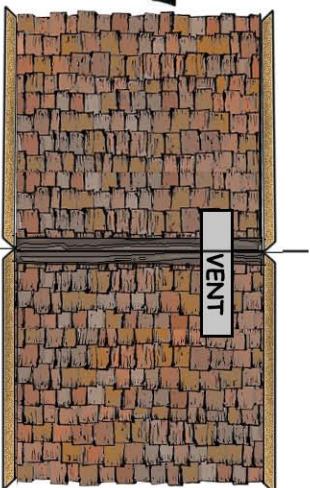
