

Spruces are large trees, from 66-200 ft tall when mature, and can be distinguished by their whorled branches and conical form. Blue spruce is a medium-sized evergreen tree growing to 80-135 ft tall, and with a trunk diameter of up to 5 feet. The bark is thin and gray, with narrow vertical furrows. The crown is conic in young trees, becoming cylindric in older trees.

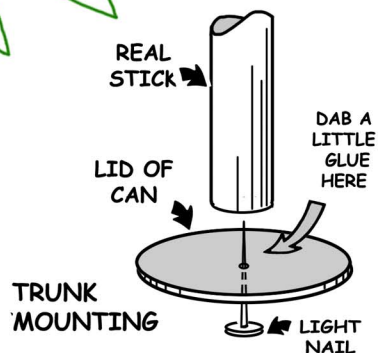
It is native and widely occurring in the montane zone of the central and southern Rocky Mountains. Commonly planted as an ornamental. Large spruce trees in people's yard were often once little Christmas trees..



SIMPLY GLUE THE SECTIONS WITH A GLOB OF GLUE AT THE TIP OF EACH CONE. TO KEEP THE COLORS ARTISTICALLY ARRANGED, TRY TO KEEP THE SEAMS MORE OR LESS ALIGNED.

LOOK FOR A STICK THAT WOULD MAKE A NICE TRUNK AND GLUE IT UP INTO THE LOWER CONE OF THE 'TREE'
